Ring 1 Equitation

9.30am Start

Equitation classes will be judged on riding ability alone and competitors will not be required to jump with the exception of Riding Club Horse/Pony.

Please note - Snaffle Bridles only in Equitation classes (1,2,3& 9)

Class 1 Lead rein Equitation

Rider 9yrs and under on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 2 Nursery Equitation

8yrs to 11yrs on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 3 Junior Equitation

12yrs to 17yrs on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 4 Novice Horse/Pony or Rider

Class to be judged on the ability of Horse/Pony/Rider for the age/level they are at. An ideal introduction to the show ring.

Class 5 New Combination

Open to new combination Horse/Pony & Rider (First full season).

Class 6 Junior and Senior Horsemanship

Open. Placed separately. Competitors will be required to perform their own 2 minute show to showcase their abilities E.g. turn on forehand, canter serpentine, rein back Etc. No Go-round.

Class 7 Riding Club Horse

To include a small jump. Any suitable bridle.

Class 8 Riding Club Pony

To include a small jump. Any suitable bridle.

RC Horse/Pony to be judged on suitability for all Riding club activities.

Class 9 Senior Equitation

18yrs+ over 1st Jan 2021.

Ring 2 Ridden Showing

10.00am Start

Class 10 Lead Rein Show/Hunter Pony

Not exceeding 12.2hh. Rider 9yrs and under on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 11 First Ridden - Pony

not to exceed 12.2hh. Rider 12yrs and under on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 12 Mountain and Moorland Lead Rein Pony

Rider 9yrs and under on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 13 First Ridden Mountain and Moorland

Rider 12yrs and under on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 14 Show/Riding Pony

Not exceeding 14.2hh. Rider any age.

Class 15 Ridden Palomino/Spotted/Dun/Roan

Open age/height.

Class 16 Mountain and Moorland Small Breeds

Rider any age.

Class 17 Pony of Show Hunter Type

15hh and under. Rider any age.

Class 18 Novice Showing

Open. Snaffle bridle only.

Lunch Break (Class 19 will not commence before 2pm)

Class 19 Novice Mixed Mountain and Moorland

Snaffle bridle only.

Class 20 Ridden Veterans, 15yrs and over

Class 21 Ridden Coloured, Non Native/Native/Cob/Trad

This class may be split.

Class 22 Riding /Show /Hack

Mare or Gelding 4yrs old and over, exceeding 148cm. Rider any age.

Class 23 Ridden Gypsy Cobs

Open to coloured and solid colour traditional cobs.

Class 24 Mountain And Moorland Large Breed

Rider any age.

Class 25 Ridden Arab

Pure, Part And Anglo.

Class 26 Horse Of Hunter Type

Over 15hh. Rider any age.

Class 27 Ridden Cob./ Traditional / Heavy Horse

Open to Cobs, Hairies & Heavies (Not for M&M's).

Class 28 Ex Racehorse or Sport Horse/Pony

Ponies must be 13.2hh or under

Class 29 Tiny Tots Lead Rein Equitation

Pony not to exceed 122cm. Rider 6years and under on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 30 Style & Appearance

To be judged 50% appearance & 50% best show. LR permitted.

Class 31 First Year Competitors

For those showing their pony in their first season.

Canter not required. LR permitted.

Class 32 First Year First Ridden

10 years and under on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 33 Best Figure of 8 in Trot

10 years and under (ridden). LR not permitted.

Class 34 In Hand Show Pony or M&M

10 years and under.

Class 35 Tiny Tot Handler

8 years and under.

Class 36 Thelwell / Bonny Pony In Hand or Ridden

Rider/handler 10yrs & under. LR permitted.

Class 37 Nicest Trot

10 years and under (ridden). LR permitted.

Class 38 Riding Club Pony

Lead rein and first ridden (tiny cross pole).

Parents are allowed in the ring in all of the classes above.

Class 44 Arabs, pure, part or Anglo

Class 45 Veterans, 15 years and over

Class 46 Mountain and Moorland, Small breeds

To be shown in a natural state.

Class 47 Coloured, Native/Non- Native/Cob/Traditional

Class 48 In Hand Gypsy Cobs

Open to coloured and solid colour traditional cobs.

Class 49 Child Handler

Handler must not have attained their 13th birthday in the current year. Judged on the child's ability to show the pony.

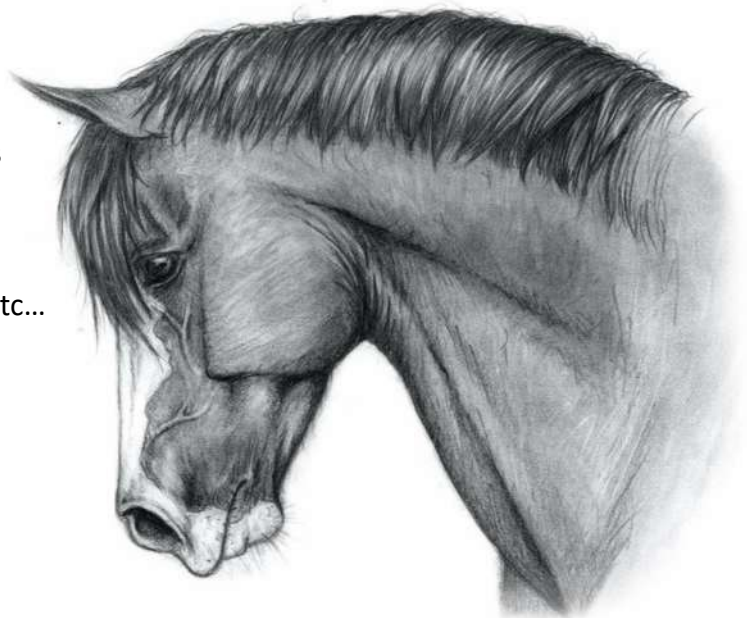

Points are accumulated throughout the season for a chance to win an award at the presentation dance.

- All Intro tests are walk and trot only. (Lead Rein permitted)
- Open Intro is open to anyone.
- Both Prelim tests are open classes.
- Plain Snaffle bridles only in all tests (See the British Dressage website for more details regarding permitted bits).



Entries may be made by phone, post, our mobile app or abramhallrc.co.uk up to four days prior to the competition. Entry fees must be received by the Tuesday prior to the competition to guarantee places. Please add 50p for cheques, made payable to "AHRC". Dressage times will be published on our website and app, or phone for times on Thursday between 6 and 8pm (01942 707021/ 07835 931603). Cancellations made after the Wednesday before the test will result in forfeiture of entry fees.

We are also participating in the ROR Retraining of Racehorses Points League.

Junior riders must be under 17yrs on 1st Jan 2021. Well behaved stallions will be permitted with a competent rider. Beginner's tests are open to beginner Riders to dressage who have never won an open prelim test or competed at novice level. Once you have won the beginners test 3 times you may not enter it again excepting Lead Rein. Special awards will be presented at the end of the season for most improved Junior/Senior.

All heights stated are Maximum heights. Well behaved stallions will be permitted with a competent rider.

Doesn't go into Championship. May not compete in open classes.

Class 1a Beginners Working hunter juniors under 10s

max height 50cm

Doesn't go into Championship. May not compete in open classes.

Class 2 Novice working Hunter Junior (excluding M & M)

Max height of fences 60cm. Rider under 17yrs on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 3 Open Working Hunter Junior (excluding M & M)

Max height of fences 75cm. Rider under 17yrs on 1st Jan 2021.

Class 4 Beginners Working Hunter Senior

Cross poles only. Rider over 17yrs on 1st Jan.

Doesn't go into Championship. May not compete in open classes.

Class 5 Novice Working Hunter Senior (excluding M & M)

Max height of fences 70cm

Class 6 Working Show horse/Pony/Cob/Traditional etc (Excluding M&M)

Open age & Height. Max height of fences 70cm

Class 7 Open Working Hunter Senior (excluding M & M)

Max height of fences 85cm

Lunch Break (Clear Round 30 Mins)

Class 8 Novice M & M Small Breeds

Max height of fences 50cm

Class 9 Novice M & M Large Breeds

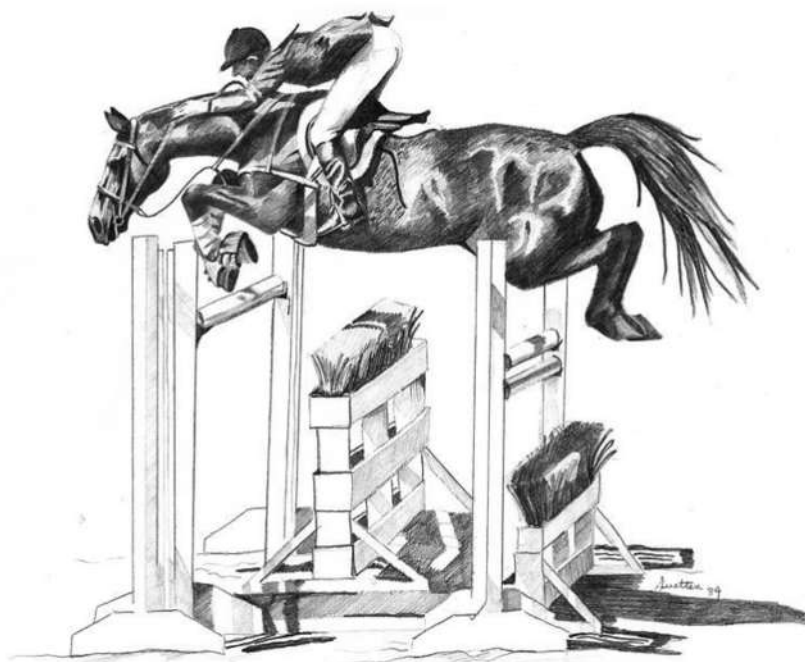

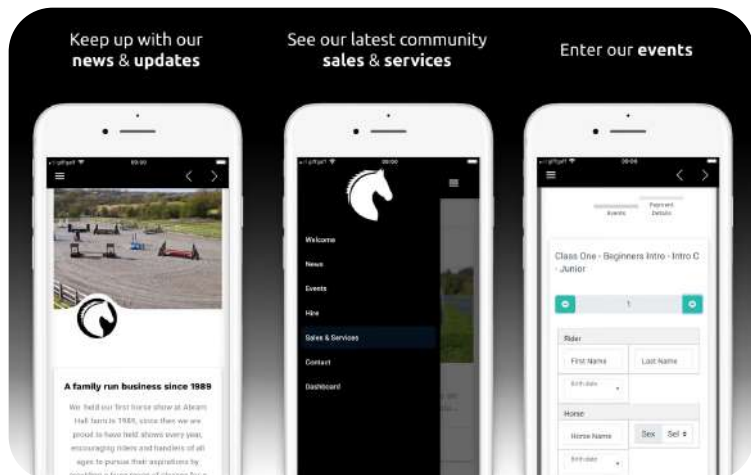

From the M6:

Use junction 23, head down the A580 (East Lancashire Road) towards Manchester
At the first roundabout, take the first exit on to the A573 (heading towards Wigan). Follow this road (do not turn off it at all) for approximately 3 miles. You will pass a pub on the left called the Dover Lock. Go over the canal bridge, past a row of parked cars, a bus shelter and railings on the left. Turn left after the railings between terraced houses 376 and 378.

From the M60:

Use junction 14, head down the A580 (East Lancashire Road) towards Liverpool for approximately 10 miles to the second roundabout, take the third exit onto the A573 (heading towards Wigan). Follow this road (do not turn off it at all) for approximately 3 miles. You will pass a pub on the left called the Dover Lock. Go over the canal bridge, past a row of parked cars, a bus shelter and railings on the left. Turn left after the railings between terraced houses 376 and 378.
