

Job Specification: Weekend Yard Manager at Wirral Riding Centre

Key Responsibilities:

- Organise staff rota and disseminate appropriately
- Organising staff on a daily basis by giving each staff member key responsibilities
- Liaising with the proprietor, riding school and yard managers when organising, supporting and disciplining staff
- To discipline staff where necessary
- Mucking out/skipping out
- Sweeping the yard
- General tidiness of the yard
- Organising and keeping allocated areas tidy such as the feed room, tack room and storage areas
- Running the office

The role of horse care can vary depending on experience, but may involve:

- Organising necessary care for horses/ponies such as the farrier, dentist, vet (this list is not exhaustive)
- Liasing and communicating with all equine professionals
- Liasing and communicating with liveries to ensure the organisation and welfare of their horse or pony
- Grooming and treatment of all injuries
- Turning out or bringing in from the field
- Performing field and yard checks to ensure and maintain the safety of the yard
- Ordering and maintain bedding, feed and all necessary medical supplements
- Deciding on appropriate tack, tacking up, untacking and taking care of tack
- Leading in and out of arenas
- Organising the majority of lesson preparation and supporting other instructors with lesson preparation
- Assisting customers
- Supporting riders

The role of instructing can vary depending on experience, but may involve:

- Preparing and teaching 1-1 lessons that match the experience and ability of the rider and horse or pony
- Preparing and teaching group lessons that match the experience and ability of the rider and horse or pony
- Willingness to progress onto and/or through to BHS qualifications
- Organising and running events

Essential Skills and Qualifications:

- Extensive equine experience
- Excellent communication skills
- Passion for working with horses
- Patience and empathy towards horses
- The ability to multitask
- Flexibility
- The ability to plan and teach progressive lessons

Desirable Skills and Qualifications:

- BHS stages
- Safeguarding training (inc Prevent and/or Safer Recruitment)
