Record a video of **maximum 2 minutes** including the competitor stating the class name and full date to ensure entries aren't re-used. To enter you must visit abramhallrc.co.uk or download the "Abram Hall Riding Club" app and book in whatever classes you wish to enter. You must then go to the **hoofpick.tv** website, and submit the video in the following format:

Classes 8, 9, 10, 19 & 20 are judged by votes on the hoofpick.tv website so it is in your best interest to submit your video early in the month in order to get the most views.

Virtual Showing/Fun Classes:

Class 1 Best turned out for the judge – Plaited (Ridden or In Hand)

Class 2 Best turned out for the judge M&M (Ridden or In Hand)

Class 3 Best plaited mane

Class 4 Best Quartermarks

Classes 1 to 4 should be a walk around video showing the horse/pony as if stood up in front of the judge in a show situation. Videos should be no longer than 1 minute and will be judged on the turnout of the horse/pony according to type. Makeup may be used sparingly.

Class 5 Ridden Junior and Senior Horsemanship

Open. Placed separately. Competitors will be required to perform their own show to showcase their abilities E.g. turn on forehand, canter serpentine, rein back Etc.

Class 6 Young / Child Handler

Handler 16yrs or under on 1st Jan 2020. Judged on the child's ability to show the pony.

Class 7 Fastest time to plait a horses tail (relative to horse/pony)

Class 8 Horse/pony best party trick video

Class 9 Dog's best party trick video

Class 10 Dog's best jump

Childrens Classes:

10 Years and Under (on 1st Jan 2020) - Ponies must be 13.2hh or under

Class 11 Tiny Tots Lead Rein Equitation

Pony not to exceed 122cm. Rider 6years and under on 1st Jan 2020.

Class 12 Style & Appearance

To be judged 50% appearance & 50% best show. LR permitted.

Class 13 First Year Competitors

For those showing their pony in their first season.

Canter not required. LR permitted.

Class 14 First Year First Ridden

10 years and under on 1st Jan 2020.

Class 15 Best Figure of 8 in Trot

10 years and under (ridden). LR not permitted.

Class 16 In Hand Show Pony or M&M

10 years and under.

Class 17 Tiny Tot Handler

8 years and under.

Class 18 Nicest Trot

10 years and under (ridden). LR permitted

Class 19 Thelwell / Bonny Pony In Hand or Ridden

Rider/handler 10yrs & under. LR permitted.

Class 20 Cutest Pair

The cutest combination of pony and rider/handler



Parents are allowed to help in all of the children's classes

To enter classes 11 to 20, you must submit a 2 minute maximum video showing an initial walk around of the pony followed by a short show comprising a figure of 8 in trot, a short period of walk, a halt, salute and thank you. Lead-reins should be attached to the nose band, not the bit. You should be turned out as if you were in a show situation so correct dress is expected.

Privacy Policy

General: Your Privacy is important, your data will never be handed to 3rd Parties or used for any method other than those detailed below. Your data is stored securely with our organisers, and can't be accessed by anyone else. Membership of the Club and Entry at any of the shows is consent for the club to use your data solely as detailed above. Under GDPR you have the right to have this data removed / forgotten at any time. Having your details removed from our records will impact our ability to record your results and offer membership benefits. If you wish to discuss or request removing your details please see one of our organisers. **Membership Details:** Your membership details are held purely for the membership process of issuing and verifying your membership number of the means of discounted entries fees and recording of your entry and points record. Data held in the Membership form, includes your Name, Address, Mobile, Email Address and Membership number. **Entry Details:** Entry details are recorded on the class sheets, this comprises of your Membership Status, Back Number, Name and Horse/Pony Name and relevant placings. This data is used purely for the record of attendance and any point allocation for the placings in the class. **Points Records:** Points records are maintained during the session, which include Member Name and Horse/Pony Name and are recorded in each class entered during the session. This data is used purely for the record of attendance and any point allocation for the placings in the class. Points records are maintained and published during the season and at the final presentation evening. The points book will be available for any other members to view. Published points will be shown on the website and Facebook at the end of the season and announced at the presentation evening. Members names maybe redacted if requested in writing to the riding club.

Virtual Showing Policy

We will not refund any entry fees if any of the following conditions aren't met. Any rider of 16 years of age and under must have parental permission. Entry fees will not be refunded once an entry has been accepted however, if you contact us we will roll your entry into next month if required. We reserve the right to refuse an entry without stating a reason. Videos must be submitted by 23:59 on the last day of each month. Videos of tests must not be entered if they have already been judged in another competition. The video must be taken for the purpose of this entry only therefore you must verbally introduce your video including the class name, day, month and year or the test will be judged as non competitive (HC). Any video which we think may have been filmed during another competition or submitted for another online competition will not be accepted. You are riding at your own risk we take no responsibility for any injury occurred to either horse or rider whilst recording their video entry. Correct riding wear and footwear must be worn including an appropriate riding hat. Copyright laws must be adhered to when submitting any video footage E.g. music playing in the background. Riders aged 16 or under (on 1st Jan 2020) must state their age in the video description. Any entries not submitted in this format won't be judged or refunded under any circumstances. Classes are available for entries throughout the month until 23:59 on the last day of each month. Submissions will be judged by one of our usual, suitably qualified judges within 2 weeks of the closing date and the results posted on our website and app. Only votes made before 23:59 on the last day of each month will be counted.
